got ready



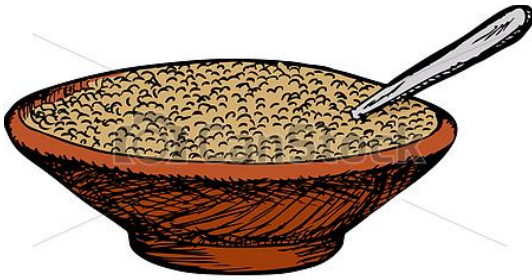
takeoff

as points of light in the night sky



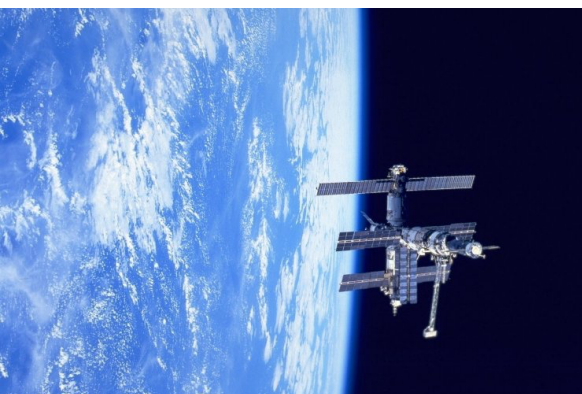
astronomers
