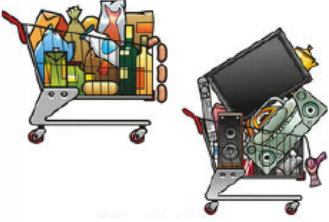
consumer
